**C: In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.**

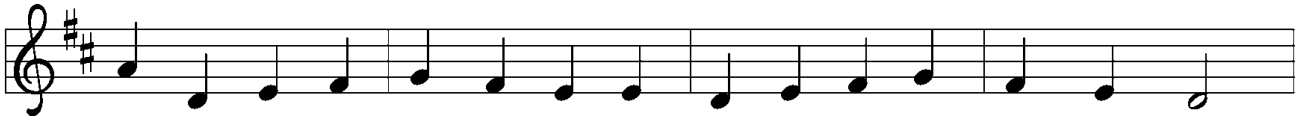
**DECLARATION OF FORGIVENESS:**
