

Bartholomew County is expecting 50,000-200,000 visitors traveling here to view the total solar eclipse on Monday, April 8.

There will be several events starting Friday, April 5 through Monday, April 8.

What should you know?

- City of Columbus and Bartholomew County offices and buildings will be closed on Monday, April 8 as employees will be providing support to our first responders and events.
- There will be no City of Columbus curbside collections on Monday, April 8. All curbside collections are delayed one day, with Friday pickups occurring on Saturday, April 13.
- Bartholomew Consolidated School Corporation, Flat Rock Hawcreek Schools, IUPUC, Ivy Tech, Purdue Polytechnic, and the Columbus Learning Center will be closed on Monday, April 8.
- Not only will visitors travel to our community, but they will also travel through the county to get to their final viewing destination. TRAFFIC WILL BE CONGESTED throughout the weekend, and specifically on Monday, April 8.
- If you are an employer, please consider adjusting shifts or shutdowns. It will be difficult for
 employees to travel to and from work in a timely manner. For more information on business logistics

- ColumBUS will run limited routes Saturday, April 6 Monday, April 8. Please plan accordingly. Special routes will be established to events downtown and AirPark Columbus.
